ABOUT LAST NIGHT Gavin Sheets delivered a game-tying home run with two outs in the ninth, but the Barons dropped their third straight game in an 8-7 decision to the Jackson Generals on Friday night. The Generals plated four runs in the opening frame to take a commanding lead, and while Birmingham fought back to tie the game late, Jackson walked it off in the ninth on an infield single by Jamie Westbrook.

IN GENERAL ... The Generals have scored eight runs or more in a game against the Barons six separate times this season. Jackson owns an average offensive output of 7.2 runs per game across its 11 wins against Birmingham this season.

ONE-RUN CONTESTS The Barons had won six consecutive one-run games prior to their 8-7 loss Friday night. Birmingham is 11-11 overall in one-run contests this season.

MAGIC MAN Barons second baseman Nick Madrigal owns the Southern League's longest active hitting streak at 16 games after his two-hit effort Friday night. Madrigal holds a .391 clip at the plate across the 16-game stretch. He has 12 multi-hit games compared to just four hitless contests in Double-A.

GAVIN IN A GROOVE Barons first baseman Gavin Sheets is in the midst of a 29-game on-base streak, which is tied with Eddy Alvarez (2017) for Birmingham's longest such stretch since Christian Marrero reached base in 31 consecutive games between May 19 - Aug. 2, 2014.

MONEY MEDEIROS Barons left-hander Kodi Medeiros continued his dominant display out of the bullpen with three scoreless frames of relief work Friday night. The 23-year-old southpaw, who owned an 0-8 mark with a 7.75 ERA and 2.04 WHIP across nine starts, holds a 3-0 record with a 1.46 ERA and 0.93 WHIP through eight relief appearances.

HIT THE SHOWERS Barons third baseman Ti'Quan Forbes was ejected for arguing balls and strikes Friday night, which marked Birmingham's first ejection of the season and its first since former manager Ryan Newman hit the showers early during a rain delay Aug. 2, 2018.

LAND OF LINCOLN Barons starter Lincoln Henzman has allowed no more than three earned runs in each of his past five starts. The 24-year-old right-hander has logged three quality starts in that span and lowered his Double-A ERA from 9.28 to 4.43, as well.
